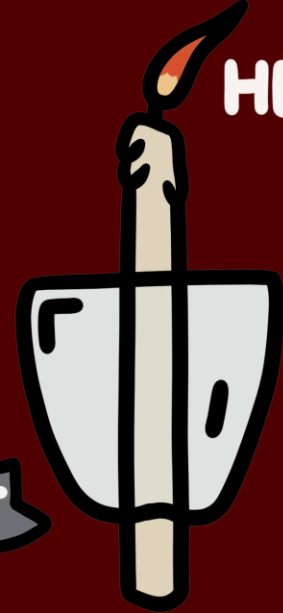

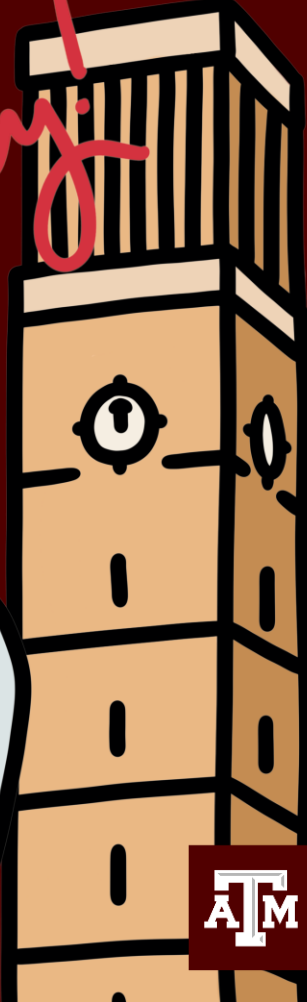

- Admissions Application
  - Common App & Apply Texas
- Essay A
- Application fee or fee waiver
  - \$75 Domestic, \$90 International
- Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR)

## **Optional:**

- Official SAT/ACT score
- Letters of Recommendation (2)

**Attend a recognized public or private high school in Texas**

**Rank in the top 10% of graduating class**

**Ensure all required documents are received by the admissions deadline**

**Meet Uniform Admission Policy requirements**

**Graduate under the foundation curriculum with the distinguished level of achievement**

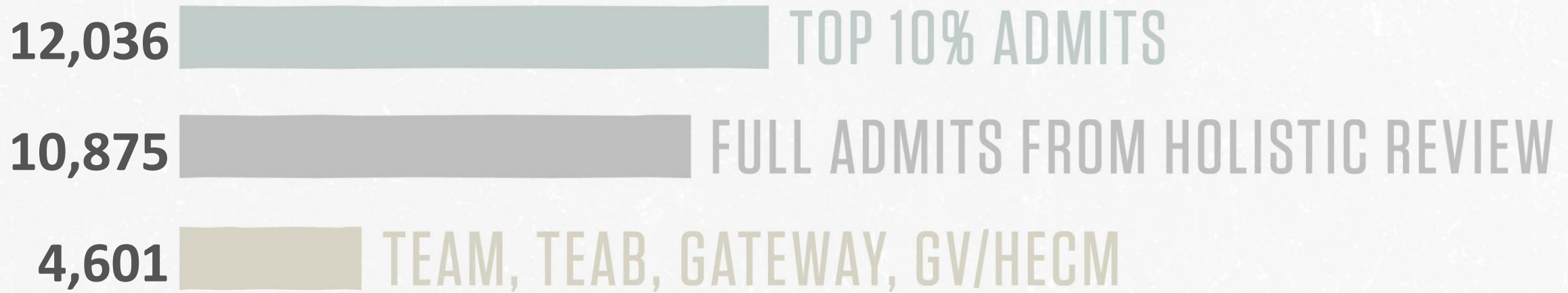

# REGENTS' SCHOLARSHIP



- Up to \$24,000 (\$6,000 per year for four years) scholarship for first generation college students
- Parents do not have a bachelor's degree
- Family income \$40,000 or less
- Awarded on a first-come, first-served basis
- (Texas Students, Only)

# OUT OF STATE TUITION WAIVER



- Student must receive at least \$4,000 in competitive scholarships from TAMU, annually
- Automatically deducts student from OOS tuition into IN-state tuition rates
- No limit to how many students can hold this
- Most common with Corps of Cadets & National Merit Scholars

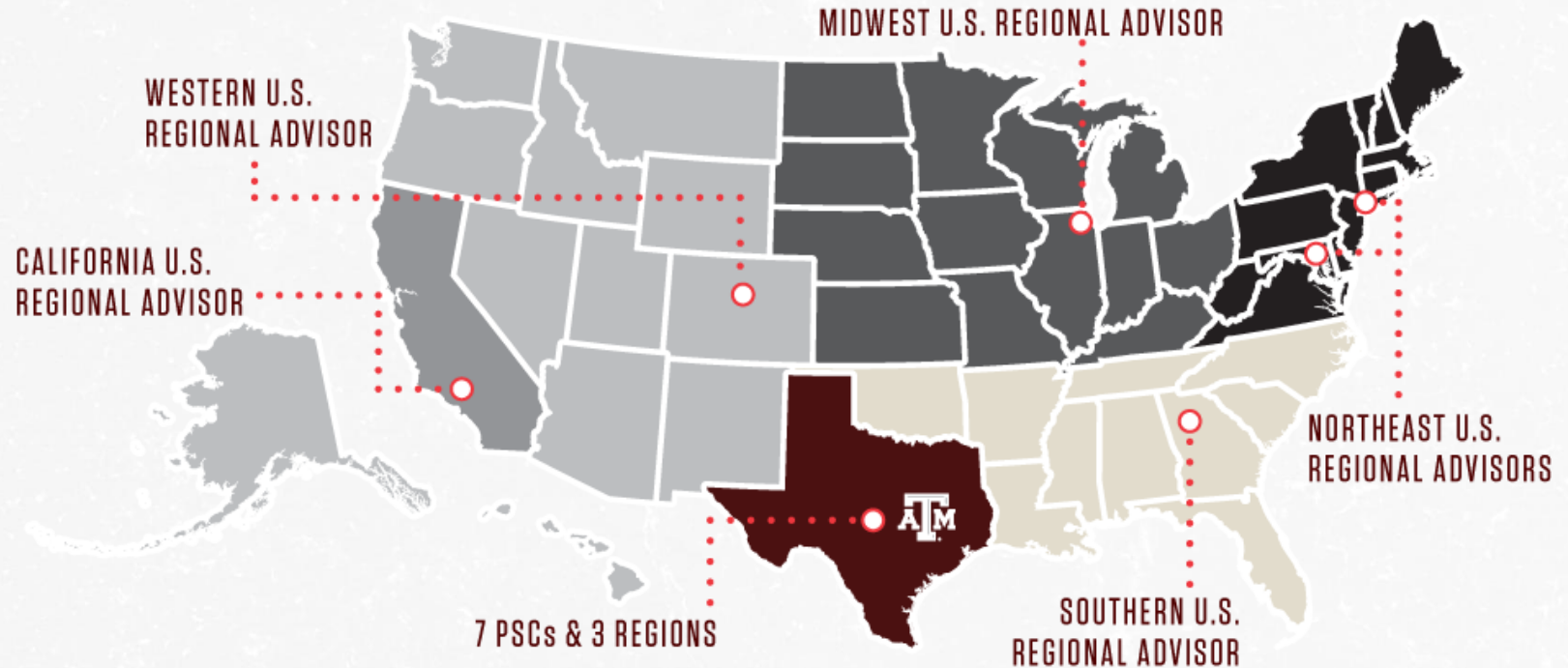
